I am helping to clean my house from top to bottom.

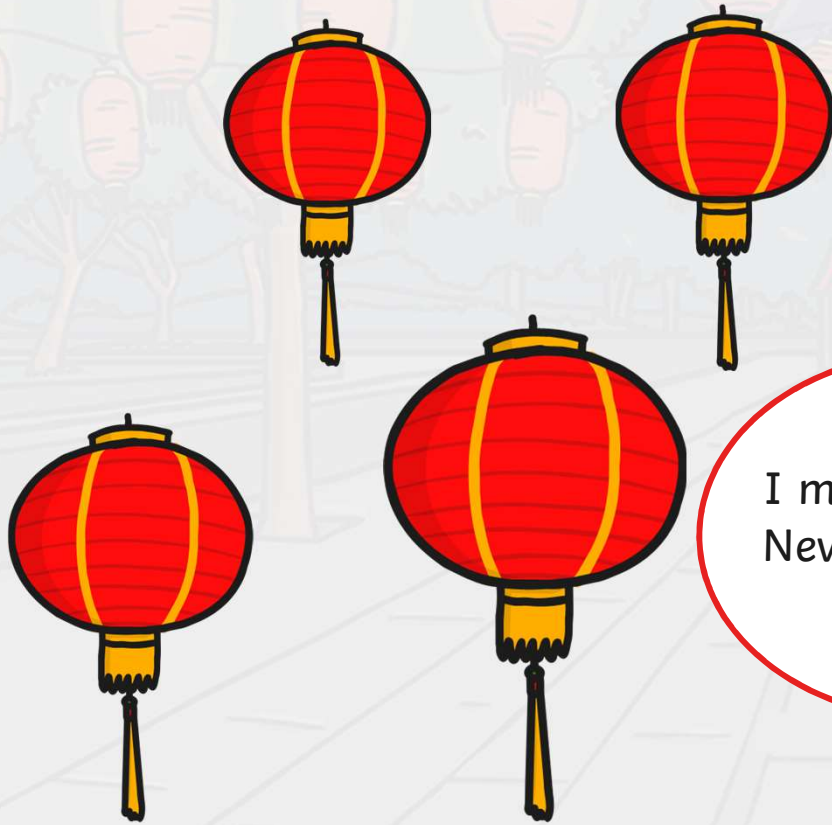
Cleaning the house removes any bad luck from the old year and welcomes in the new year.
