Dear Parents and Carers (Year 6 only),

Key Stage 2 SATS results

I am writing to let you know about an unexpected national delay to the release of this year's Key Stage 2 (SATS) results. Earlier today, the Department for Education informed schools that results, which were due to be made available on 7 July, will now not be released to schools until 16 July. This delay affects all primary schools nationally.

The Department for Education has advised that the delay is due to technical issues with the online system used to provide results to schools. They have also confirmed that this is not related to the quality of the tests, the marking process or the accuracy of pupils' results. Test papers have been marked as normal, and all quality assurance processes have been completed.

We know that many families will be disappointed and frustrated by this news, and we share that frustration. Across the Diamond Learning Partnership Trust, teachers have spent many hours preparing end-of-year reports to ensure families receive a comprehensive picture of their child's achievements, progress and development over the year. For our Year 6 pupils, the KS2 outcomes are an important part of that picture and were intended to be the final piece of the jigsaw before reports are shared with families.

The timing of this delay is particularly challenging, falling at one of the busiest points of the school year when many schools are finalising reports, preparing for transition events and, in some cases, taking pupils on residential visits. Despite these circumstances being completely outside schools' control, we are committed to doing everything we can to ensure results are communicated to families as quickly as possible once they are released to us.

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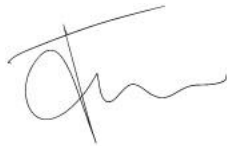
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Importantly, this delay will not affect your child's transition to secondary school. Secondary schools are aware of the national situation and the information they require will still be available through the usual channels.

We appreciate your patience and understanding. As soon as results are made available to schools on 16 July, we will work hard to ensure they are shared with families before the end of term wherever possible. We will provide further updates if any additional information becomes available.
