Dear Parents and Carers

I would like to welcome you all to the start of this school year at Wintringham. The staff have been working hard getting everything ready for the children and we have planned lots of activities. It was lovely to see so many smiling faces coming into school and to hear about the children's summer holidays. They have all come back ready for learning and have really settled into their new classes. Our new children in Reception are getting to know their teachers and are quickly learning our school routines. Their teachers are very proud of them.

Next week History Off The Page will be leading sessions with the children in Year 2 and Year 3. Year 2 will immerse themselves in life at the time of The Great Fire of London and Year 3 will experience life in Roman Britain. The children have all come into school looking very smart this term. Please can you ensure that and school shoes are black and that they are not trainers. Your child should keep their PE kit in school all week (taking it home at the weekends to be washed if necessary), as we sometimes need to change PE days. Please note that these must be removed for PE or sporting activities, and your child will not be able to participate if they can't be removed. We do allow children to wear plastic retainers that can be obtained online for PE.

Please can I remind everyone to park considerately around the school. Please walk your children to school if at all possible. If you do have to drive, please be mindful of the residents who live in the streets near the school, who may need to use their cars to get to appointments, and ensure that you are not blocking any driveways. Thank you in advance for this.
