

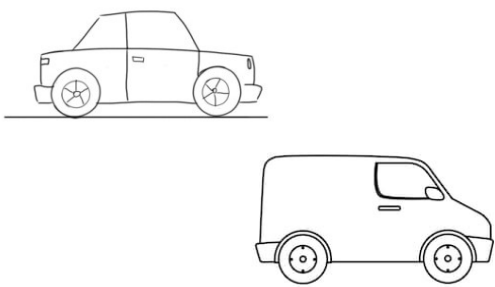
1. Using some playdough, can you make different types of transport?



2. Can you do some cooking with an adult? See if you can follow a simple recipe, using scales to measure how much of each ingredient you need.



3. What vehicles can you see outside your window? Can you draw a picture of one of them?



4. Can you find and complete the inventor scavenger hunt by finding the things on the list below?

Can you find:

- Something that you can turn.
- Something that is bumpy.
- Something that is metal.
- Three things that are round.
- Something you can twist.
- Something shiny.
- Something you can roll.
- A tube.
- Three things that are squishy.
- Something that is clear.
- Something that can bounce.

5. Can you make a train for all of your teddies? Place some chairs or use cushions along the floor one behind the other for the carriages, then place a teddy on each one. Where will your train take your teddies?



6. Re-cap the nursery rhyme 'Little Miss Muffet' and discuss the following questions. Where did Little Miss Muffet go? Why was she frightened? Do you think the spider was frightened too? Why?



7. Can you pretend you are going on an airplane? Where would you go? Make a passport and a ticket for yourself and anyone else who you want to come with you.



Challenge – can you draw a picture and write the word for the things you found on your scavenger hunt?



8. Measure the people in your house. Who is the tallest and who is the smallest?



Challenge – can you write a sentence about what you have found out?

9. Can you wrap up some parcels (using things from your recycling box) ready to go in your delivery van? Can you drive your van and deliver them to people in your house?



10. Can you match up loose socks and put them into pairs? How many socks are there altogether? How many pairs have you made? Can you count in 2's to check how many socks you have altogether? Can you time yourself and see if you can do it any quicker?
