Young Voices Choir Trip to the O2 for Year 6 – Thursday 22nd January 2026

Young Voices is fast approaching and Mr Colborne, Mrs Fraser, Mrs George-Sloan and the children are looking forward to the concert and the children are working hard at learning their songs.

The children will come to school as normal (in full school uniform) on Thursday 22nd January and, if they ordered one, will be given their Young Voices t-shirt before departure. If your child hasn't ordered a Young Voices t-shirt, they will need to bring a plain white t-shirt to wear for the performance please. A clean white P.E. t-shirt will be fine.

Coaches will depart at 8.45am, so please can you ensure that all children are in school promptly at 8.20am. Once at the O2 the children will spend the day rehearsing with all the other schools and will then perform in the evening. The coach is scheduled to depart the O2 at 9.15pm and return to school at approximately 11.30pm. If there are significant changes to these timings we will update you via Facebook. If you have not joined the Facebook group, please do so and speak to the school office if you experience any difficulty in doing this. Please ensure that an emergency contact number, that will be available all day and all evening, is provided on the slip below as this number will be used in the event of an emergency. Please also confirm on the slip the name of the adult who will be collecting your child. Please note that children will not be allowed to walk home without an adult. **Just a reminder that parents who have bought tickets to watch the performance will need to make their own way to and from the arena.** It will not be possible to collect your child directly from the O2 Arena. The tickets are digital this year and will be emailed to parents who have ordered them by another school in the Trust, Winhills Primary Academy.

Children will need to bring a warm coat, lots of water (no fizzy drinks or glass bottles) and **TWO** good sized packed lunches as it is a very long day (one for lunch and one for dinner). These must be carried in one backpack type bag which can be easily carried and stored under a seat. If your child is entitled to free school meals, we are able to provide you with **one** packed lunch (wrap, fruit, and a cake/biscuit) for the trip. If you require a packed lunch from school, please email the school office to let us know by **Friday 16th January**.

Children **must not** bring mobile phones, cameras, money or other valuables. School staff will take photographs that they will put on Facebook and will be in touch with school by phone.

If your child requires a school meal on the day after (Friday 23rd, we will need to know this in advance (menu choices are fish fingers, cheese whirl or a jacket potato). **Please add their meal choice to the form below.**

If no choice is made, we will assume that your child is having a packed lunch on the Friday.
