



Christmas Events at Wintringham – KS2

We have been planning Christmas activities for the children to take part in and enjoy during their time at school before the Christmas holidays.



The **Christmas Post Box** will be in school from **Monday 1st December**, so children can send cards to their friends. Please ensure that your child writes the full name of the child and the child's class clearly on each envelope, so that every item of Christmas post is delivered to the correct child.

The school will, as usual, be decorated by the staff after school on Friday 28th November ready for the festivities to begin. As a school we are looking to decorate using sustainable materials, and I have been impressed with the ideas that the children and staff have come up with. We will hold our usual whole school assembly where the children "wish" the Christmas lights on and I am sure that the classrooms will be decorated beautifully. We are hoping that each child will make a **Christmas decoration** at home to place on a Christmas tree in school. The decoration can be very simple – made from card, paper and one or two glitzy bits and does not need to be made by the child. There will be prizes for the most attractive tree decorations made by the children at school. Please send all decorations to school by the morning of **Monday 1st December**, so that they can be placed on the tree that morning. Please ensure that the decoration has your child's full name and class on it, and then it can be returned home to decorate your Christmas tree this year.

A separate letter has been sent home with details of the children's **CHRISTMAS LUNCH**, which is on **Wednesday 17th December**. It is really important that you complete the online form by **24th November** with a choice for your child – even if your child has a school dinner every day or they would like a packed lunch.



Reward Day is on **Thursday 18th December**. You will receive a letter to confirm if your child is participating in Reward Day.

We will be holding a Christmas Fair at Wintringham after school on Thursday 4th December and further details will be provided in due course. Santa will be attending the fair!

KS2 classes will be walking to Church for a carol service on the last day of term, Friday 19th December. Please ensure that your child has a warm, waterproof coat and suitable shoes for the walk with them that day.

The KS2 school production will take place in the Summer term.
