

This link will only be live until **10.00am on Monday 30th June**, you must therefore submit your form by this date. Any late requests will need to be emailed to the school office, and will not be processed until all online requests have been allocated. Your online application will be acknowledged, but this does not guarantee your ticket allocation. Tickets will be allocated and parents will be notified nearer to the performance date.

Please note that your child will need to be back in school at 5.00pm on the 7th and 8th July to change and prepare for the evening performance. It is crucial that we know well in advance if your child cannot attend the evening performances, although we strongly ask that this does not happen unless there are exceptional circumstances as all children have their part to play whether it is on stage, in the singing and/or the dancing. If your child cannot attend the evening performance, please email the school office as soon as possible.

Children will be ready to be collected after the evening performance at approximately 6.40pm (if you are not attending this performance). Please note that due to the time that the performance will end, all children must be collected and cannot walk home by themselves. If your child is being collected by someone other than yourselves, please could you let us know in advance.
