Year 3 trip to The Tower of London – Friday 11th July

As part of our learning this year on 'The Tudors', we are planning to take all Year 3 children to The Tower of London. Whilst there, the children will attend a workshop called 'Stories from the Tower', where they will learn more about the history of the Tower of London.

The total cost of the trip is £ 16.00 per child, which has been subsidised by the school and is to be paid via Arbor. We will be travelling to London by train and children should arrive promptly for registration at the usual time. The train from St Neots station will arrive at London Bridge station where we will take a 20-minute walk across London Bridge to the Tower of London. We plan on returning to school at approximately 5.30pm. This time will be confirmed nearer the time.

Your child will need the following:

- A packed lunch in a named bag. Please ensure that all items are disposable (no fizzy drinks, yoghurts or chocolate please).
- Small rucksack/bag
- A named water bottle
- Children must wear school uniform.
- Appropriate clothing for the weather conditions on the day e. g jumper if cold and windy, sun hat if it is sunny.
