Year 6 SATs

You are no doubt aware that the Year 6 children are due to take their SATs during the week commencing Monday 12th May 2025. Please find the timetable for these assessments below:

<u>Date</u>	<u>Test</u>
Monday 12 th May	English grammar, punctuation and spelling test Paper 1: Short answer questions Paper 2: Spelling task
Tuesday 13 th May	English Reading test
Wednesday 14 th May	Mathematics Paper 1: Arithmetic Paper 2: Reasoning A
Thursday 15 th May	Mathematics Paper 3: Reasoning B

The Grammar and Maths papers test the children's knowledge of units they have covered across Key Stage Two – they are not designed to test their reading ability. For this reason, we strongly advise the children to have as many questions read out loud to them by an adult. The only test where we cannot do this is obviously the Reading test.

The SATs are extremely important to your child, as an individual and to the school as a whole. It is vital that your child attends school during this week, as it is not possible to take a test at any other time apart from the specified day/dates. If your child is ill, please notify the school as early as possible.

To make the week a little less stressful, we will be holding a breakfast club from 8.15am on Monday – Thursday during this week; there is no charge for this club. This is designed to be a light-hearted breakfast, giving the children a chance to relax with their friends before each paper. Please
