Wintringham Home Learning

To ensure that our children can consolidate their learning, we have organised opportunities for home learning. All logins for online platforms will be found in the children's school diaries. Every Monday, the class teacher will monitor their engagement.

For reading records, please can you ensure for every read you write the date, the title of the book and the page numbers read, for example 16/09/24, Diary of a Wimpy Kid, p 16 - 43

The expectations for all the classes are below:

EYFS (Reception)

- Reading – children are expected to read their phonics book at least 5 times weekly. Reads each week will be recorded in class (maximum of 7 reads each week), with certificates awarded for cumulative reads over each term. A reading for pleasure book will also go home to read with parents as well.
- Maths - NumBots is available to all children as an additional home learning opportunity.

Key Stage 1 (Years 1 & 2)

- Reading – children are expected to read their phonics (or AR book) at least 5 times weekly for 10 minutes. Reads each week will be recorded in class (maximum of 7 reads each week), with certificates awarded for cumulative reads over each term. There will be a class reward for the class with the most reads per child.
- Maths - NumBots is available to all children as an additional home learning opportunity.

Lower Key Stage 2 (Year 3 & 4)

- Reading - children are expected to read their AR book at least 5 times weekly for 10 minutes. Monday lunchtimes will be used to ensure that children have the opportunity to catch up on missed reads each week - this will be run by the senior leadership team (SLT). Reads each week will be recorded in class (maximum of 7 reads each week), with certificates awarded for cumulative reads over each term. All children who have read on 50 occasions this term up to Monday 16th December will receive a reward of extra play time at the end of term.
- Maths - children are expected to complete 15 games on TT Rockstars (or NumBots- this will be outlined by teachers on an individual basis) each week. If it is not completed, paper copies will be provided during a break time.

Upper Key Stage 2 (Year 5 & 6)

- Reading - children are expected to read their AR book at least 5 times weekly for 10 minutes. Monday lunchtimes will be used to ensure that children have the opportunity to catch up on missed reads each week - this will be run by the senior leadership team (SLT). Reads each week will be recorded in class (maximum of 7 reads each week), with certificates awarded for cumulative reads over each term. All children who have read on 50 occasions this term up to Monday 16th December will receive a reward of extra play time at the end of term.
- Maths - www.maths.co.uk (or TT Rockstars/NumBots- as directed by the class teacher) will be used to set a selection of questions each week. This will be set on a Monday and completed by the following Monday. Paper copies linked to this will be provided during break time if this is not completed.

Other home learning opportunities

Spelling Shed is available to all children to practice their class spellings.

The 100 Reads Challenge will also run alongside this as an extra opportunity for children to read and share books at home.
