Dear Parents and Carers,

It was lovely to welcome all of the children back to school this week, and to see so many eager new faces excited to join us here at Wintringham. We hope that you can all quickly settle into school life with us. Please remember that the school gates open at 8.30am with the classroom doors opening at 8.35am so that the children can be sat at their desks ready for registration at 8.45am. The gate will be closed at 8.45am, and any children who arrive after this time will need to go to the school office to be registered as a late arrival prior to going to class.

We have some new members of staff joining us this term, Miss Garcia and Mrs Carroll in Inkpen and Ahlberg classes with our new Reception children, and Miss Hayllar in Rosen class with Year 1. We also welcome Mr Anns as a deputy headteacher alongside Mr Hall who will also be taking up a deputy head role.

We are looking forward to a very busy term. We have two History Off the Page days taking place next week where Ancient Egypt and Medieval England will be brought to life for Years 3 & 4 and 1 & 2 respectively. Bikeability sessions for those children in Years 5 and 6 who registered last term will be taking place from 16<sup>th</sup> September. We will also soon be restarting Forest School sessions for some of the children, and there are events for most classes just around the corner. More details for these events will follow in separate communications nearer the time.

Please can I take this opportunity to pass on a few reminders about school uniform. All children must be wearing proper school shoes and not trainers (guidance for acceptable style of school shoes can be found on our school website). Nail varnish should be removed before coming to school, and long hair should be tied back. P.E. kits should not include football shirts or cycling shorts.

We are also pleased that we have been able to open most sessions of Cygnets, our wraparound care provision, here at Wintringham this term. The Friday after school session will still take place with Magpies at The Round House until numbers increase sufficiently to open the session here. As soon as this is in place to start, we will communicate with all of the parents at the school to let them know.
