Dear Parents & Carers,

After School Clubs – Summer Term 2026

Please find attached a list of our Teacher Led after-school clubs that we will be running this term. Not every club is open to all year groups, but there is lots of choice. **Please keep this information safe for your future reference, the attached schedule indicates any weeks where individual clubs will not be running.** The after-school clubs are run for children from Reception to Year 6 in the Summer Term. The club schedule attached to this letter details which clubs are open to which year groups.

You will need to complete an online form for each child that wishes to attend a club and will only be able to select a maximum of two choices. Please be aware that each child will only be allocated one club, and that we will do our best to give each student their first choice.

If your child selects a club as their first choice but they have already attended previously, they will be offered their second choice to allow other children to have the opportunity to join.

If you have paid the annual contribution for your child, there will be no charge to attend any of these after-school clubs. **If you have not made your annual contribution, unfortunately your child will not be allocated a space and therefore will be unable to attend a club. This does not apply to an invitation only club.**

The link will be live from **2.00pm** today **17th April** and will only stay live until **Tuesday 21st April at 10.00am**. You **must** make your choices by this date so that we have enough time to allocate places for clubs to start during the week commencing **27th April**. Any late requests will need to be emailed to the school office. These **will not** be processed until the following week once all online requests have been allocated, this will mean that your child will not be able to start on the first session of the club.

Please only select a club that is available for your child's year group. Your application will automatically be acknowledged, but this does not guarantee your child a place in this club. We will **not** be emailing you with confirmation of your child's club allocation, but you will be able to check your child's calendar within Arbor to see which club they have been allocated before the clubs start. If you do not have access to Arbor, please speak to the school office.

Please only sign up for clubs that your child intends to attend weekly. Children who regularly miss sessions of their club will be removed and the place offered to another child on the waiting list. Please also be aware that we will be unable to swap clubs once your child has been allocated a place.

Invitation Only Clubs

There are a number of invitation only clubs this term - Well Being Club and Year 2 Reading Gladiators on Mondays, Year 6 Reading Club on Tuesdays, Homework Club on Thursdays and Lego Club on Fridays. If your child has a place in any of these clubs, they will receive a separate letter informing you of this. **These clubs are not open to all children, and you will not be able to select them on the request form.** If you do receive a letter regarding an invitation only club, please complete and return the form attached to your invitation to accept or decline an offered place before the club starts. **Children that have been offered a place to an invite only club are also still able to apply for a club of their choice.**

Homework Club will start on Thursday 23rd April and KS2 Cricket Club will start on Friday 24th April. All other clubs will start week beginning **27th April**. KS2 Cricket Club on Fridays will run for ONE HOUR, finishing at 4.15pm. All other clubs run for 45 minutes and finish at 4.00pm, including Homework Club this term. The final day for clubs this term will be on **Friday 10th July. This is with the exception of KS2 Cricket Club, which will finish on the last day of term, Friday 17th July.**

Please confirm on the online form how your child will be leaving their club (walking home alone, collection by parent or going to Cygnets). Please email cygnets@wintringham.cambs.sch.uk to let them know if your child will be attending Cygnets after their club once you know a place has been allocated. As previously stated, if you wish to cancel your child's place at Cygnets, you will need to email them to give them 4 weeks' notice of the cancellation, and a place may not be available if you need one in the future.

Please could we ask that if your child is allocated a place at a club, that they attend all sessions if possible. If they start attending a club but decide that they no longer wish to continue for any reason, please could you let the school office know as soon as possible to allow the place to be offered to the next child on the waiting list. Nearly all of our clubs have waiting lists, and we would like to offer any available spaces to those on the lists as they become available.
