Dear Parents & Carers

Welcome back for another term at Wintringham Primary Academy! I hope you had a wonderful Easter and are well rested. Please find below a summary of the main learning areas during this first term, along with some general reminders.

Homework

Children will be set homework on a weekly basis. This includes:

- Reading – children are expected to read for at least 10 minutes, 5 times a week from their AR book and this should be recorded in their reading diary (date, name of book, page number) and signed by an adult.
- Maths.co.uk – this is an online tool where children will be completing selected questions
- Spelling Shed - 5 games of Spelling Shed will be set weekly. **Please note that this is a further learning opportunity.**

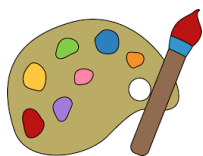
P.E.

We are looking forward to an exciting term ahead and thank you in advance for your support.

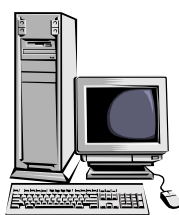

Art

In Art, the children will be learning about Sculptures and 3D: Making memories.



Computing

This term, the children will be programming music, using Scratch, which is a piece of software that they have used before.



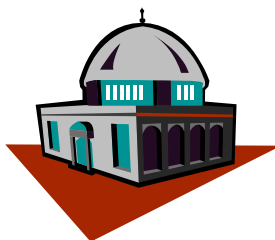
Science

This term, the children will be learning about materials. This includes: 'Properties and Changes' and 'Mixtures and Separation'. We will have a big focus on working scientifically.



History

The children will be learning about Oliver Cromwell and about the impact Cromwell had during the English Civil War.



Religion and Worldviews

The children will be looking at answering the questions, 'Who should get to be in charge?' and 'Why are some places in the world significant to others?'



Music

This term, the children will be learning about music from South Africa. This will involve a mixture of signing and composing South African music.



P.E.

The children will be participating in rounders, tennis, cricket and athletics, as well as practising for Sports Day.



Geography

The children will be learning about, 'East Anglia'. They will be using Ordnance Survey maps and understanding 4 and 6 – figure grid references.
