



Year 4 Curriculum Newsletter Summer Term 2025

Dear Parents & Carers,

We are delighted to welcome everyone back to school after the Easter break. We hope you are all ready for an exciting term of learning ahead. Please find below a summary of the main learning areas during the next term, as well as some general reminders.

Homework

Reading - children are expected to read for at least 10 minutes, 5 times a week from their AR book and this should be recorded in their reading diary (date, name of book, page number) and signed by an adult. The number of reads will be counted up each Monday so children must ensure that they have their reading diary and their AR book with them (along with a 100 read book if they have one of these too). AR club will continue to run.

TT Rockstars – Children will be set 15 minutes of TT Rockstars per week, starting on a Monday. If homework is not complete, children will catch up with this on a Monday breaktime. Next month, all children in Year 4 will sit the Multiplication Tables Check (MTC). This is a national assessment to check that all children know their multiplication table facts to 12x12. Support to help children learn those key facts at home will be hugely beneficial for your child, when it comes to the check in June 2025.

P.E.

P.E. will be on **Friday** for Year 4.

The weather remains unpredictable which makes it vitally important that children have the appropriate clothing and footwear in school for P.E. lessons to ensure that they get the best out of their lessons. P.E. uniform consists of a white t-shirt, navy shorts (no cycling shorts please), pumps/trainers, a warm plain navy top and navy jogging trousers (not leggings). A change of shoes is particularly useful when the ground is wet and muddy. Sun hats are important as the weather continues to improve. **Please be aware that children must have their P.E. kit in school all week otherwise they cannot participate.** To make sure we can keep your children safe during their P.E. sessions, please tie up long hair. Your child will be asked to remove their earrings on days that they have P.E. Any other jewellery should not be worn to school.

In art, we will be exploring sculpture and 3D art.



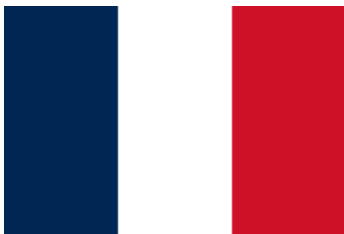
Year 4

Within DT, the children will be making pneumatic toys.



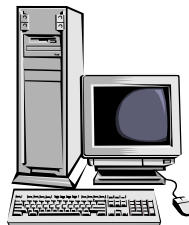
Year 4

This term, Year 4 will be looking into 'Relationships' and 'Changing Me'.



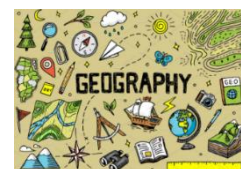
Year 4
