English & Maths

We have started reading a new story in English – 'Wombat Stew.' We have read about a sneaky character called Dingo and all the ingredients he would like to put into his stew. We have written some character descriptions with exciting adjectives to explain how Dingo feels in different parts of the story.

In maths, the children have become confident writing expressions for addition by thinking about the parts and wholes. We have explored changing the order of the parts within the calculations so they still make sense! We have used counters, cubes and other objects to show how the parts are combined to find the total. We will use this to help with our learning about subtraction next.

Science & Foundation

Subjects

In Science, the children have been exploring the different seasons in more depth. We have made weather catcher mobiles to show how seasons change from one to the next. We have described each season and what it is like, using this knowledge to make suitable choices about what to wear in different seasons, like sun hats or coats!

The children are learning about changes within living memory in History. This has included looking at how things have changed over time such as transport, communication and toys. This topic has lots of chronology and we have been ordering images from oldest to newest.
