English & Maths

In English, the children have been enjoying the book 'Skellig' by David Almond. They will be writing narratives, non-chronological reports and newspapers linked to the story.

In Maths, the children will be starting work on ration and proportion while working on problem solving and reasoning skills.

In arithmetic, we have been focussing on applying our times table knowledge, calculating percentages and adding and subtracting fractions.

Science & Foundation Subjects

In Science, the children have just begun our work on light. We will be looking at the pathway of light, shadows and how light passes through different objects.

In Geography, the children will be looking at the World's water, where it is and how it moves in an endless cycle. The children will also be discussing the differences between fresh and salt water and how lakes and reservoirs are different.
