English & Maths

In English, the children have been enjoying the book 'Skellig' by David Almond. They will be writing first person narratives, recounts and diary entries based on the book.

In Maths, the children will be starting our shape work. We will be estimating, measuring and calculating angles, identifying properties of 2D and 3D shapes and starting to investigate area, perimeter and volume.

In Arithmetic, we have been focussing on multiplying and dividing decimals, calculating percentages and simplifying fractions.

Science & Foundation Subjects

In Science, the children have been looking at inheritance and evolution. We will be looking at the evidence for evolution, e.g. fossils, and looking at how various theories of evolution have developed over time due to discoveries of fossils and development of technology.

In Geography, the children will be looking at flooding, including the causes and the effects of it. They will then be exploring water on a global scale and how water is such an important part of the world.
