## Year 1 Class Newsletter

### English & Maths

The children have been continuing to read the story of 'Bob – Man on the Moon'. The children have been using adjectives in their writing to write character descriptions and setting descriptions. They even came up with their own alternative endings to how they would have liked the story to end. After half term, we will be looking at a new text called 'Wombat Stew'.

In Year 1 Maths, the children have been exploring expressions ( $7+2$ ) and equations ( $7+2=9$ ). They have been using their number knowledge to work out missing parts in equations and have been representing these in part-whole models, bar models and writing the equations in a variety of ways.

After half term, the children will be continuing to focus on addition and subtraction.

### Science & Foundation Subjects

In Science, the children have been exploring materials. They have looked at the properties of these materials and have also tested the absorbency. The children have been using their knowledge of materials to find their suitability for different causes.

In Art, the children have been exploring how we can use paper to create different 3D sculptures. They have been rolling, folding and bending paper to create different effects.

In Religion and Worldviews, the children have been learning about different religious and world views about God and what his job is. They have explored the beliefs of Christian, Hindu, Jewish and Muslim people and why they believe different things.
