Dear Parents & Carers

Happy New Year from Wintringham! We hope you are as excited for your children to be back at school as we are and that you are looking forward to an important term ahead. We are sure you will agree that this term is a significant term in the life of your children as they will embark on their last full term before the SATs tests in May. Please find below a summary of the main learning areas during this first term, along with some general reminders.

Homework

Reading - children are expected to read for at least 10 minutes, 5 times a week from their AR book and this should be recorded in their reading diary (date, name of book, page number) and signed by an adult. The number of reads will be counted up each Monday so children must ensure that they have their reading diary and their AR book with them (along with a 100 read book if they have one of these too). AR club will continue to run.

Maths.co.uk is to be completed each week until CPG books arrive.

CPG books – children to complete one test per week (as directed by the teacher).

P.E.

P.E. for Year 6 will be on a Monday. This may be subject to change so please ensure that a P.E. kit is in school all week. Please ensure that your child has the appropriate clothing and footwear in school for these lessons: a white t-shirt, navy or black football-style shorts (not cycling shorts), trainers, a warm top, and jogging trousers (if it is colder). Please also ensure that all children have a named water bottle in school every day.

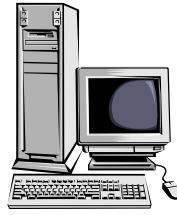
Spring Term 2024 - Curriculum Units for Year 6



Art

Our theme is 'Craft and Design: photo opportunity'.

Children will explore photographic techniques, creating new images through photomontage and applying digital photography to art and design.



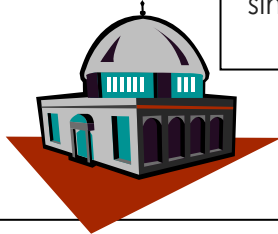
Computing

Creating Media: Stop – motion animation. The children will create a toy with simple images and a single movement, create a short stop motion with small changes between images and think of a simple story idea for their animation.



Science

Our spring sequence of work in Evolution and Inheritance. The children will be studying how adaptation and natural selection has shaped nature over time.



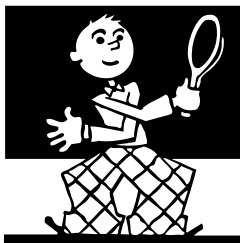
Religion and Worldviews

The children will be looking at answering the question 'Is it better to be there in person?' The children will be trying to figure out this big question by delving into different religious practise across the world. They will be focussing on feeling and being present in a moment and thinking about the effect of events on people who attend them.



Music

Blues: Recognising and confidently discussing the stylistic features of different genres, styles and traditions of music and representing the features of a piece of music using graphic notation, and colours.



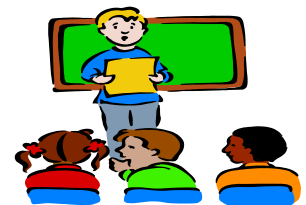
P.E.

Geography
