English & Maths

In English, the children have started to enjoy the book 'Holes' by Louis Sachar. The children have written a newspaper article, diary entry and an informal letter based on the first few chapters and, over the next few weeks, will also be writing narratives, character descriptions and formal letters.

In Maths, the children have looked at fractions of amounts and finding the whole using bar models. In the coming weeks we will be focussing on fractions, decimals and percentages, converting between them and calculating percentages of amounts.
