English & Maths

The children have been using the story 'Ossiri and the Bala Mengro' to inspire some sentences persuading Ossiri why she should or should not learn to play an instrument. We also had a go at crafting our own musical instruments and then wrote some instructions explaining how to make them. Lastly, we have designed our own 'monster' for the story and have written a character description including using adjectives.

In Maths, we have explored 2D and 3D shapes including identifying and classifying them. The children have really impressed us with their existing shape knowledge! We have revisited the features of different shapes such as counting their faces and vertices and sorting the shapes in a range of different ways.

Science & Foundation Subjects

In Science, the children have learnt about the different animal groups, including their habitats and diets, and have been using technical vocabulary such as carnivore, herbivore and omnivore.

We have been very lucky to have a sports coach to help us with our cricket skills this half term.

We are so proud of the children for their effort and enthusiasm during the winter production. It was lovely to showcase all our singing and dancing to families this week.
