English & Maths

In English, the children have continued to enjoy reading the book 'Holes' by Louis Sachar. During the next two weeks, the children will be focusing on engaging with the characters as well as making inferences about character feelings and actions. We will also be writing stories and diaries based on the book.

In Maths, the children will be continuing to practise their formal methods and will also continue to look at fractions. Once we are confident with fractions, the children will begin to look at decimals and percentages. In arithmetic, we have been practicing long multiplication.

Science & Foundation Subjects

In Science, the children will be doing an investigation that involves growing mould on bread. They will be making predictions about what they think will happen, and will then be observing the actual changes and coming to final conclusions to show why they got the results they saw. After this study, we will be starting a new unit on the human body including the circulatory system.

In History we have started our new unit on 'Ancient Greece'. We will be looking at the rise of the Ancient Greek Empire, timelines showing the different periods within it, and also the Ancient Greek gods and goddesses.
