English & Maths

In English, the children have continued to enjoy the book 'Holes' by Louis Sachar. During the next two weeks, the children will be focussing on engaging with the characters and making inferences about character feelings and actions. We will also be writing stories and diaries based on the book.

In Maths, the children will be continuing to practise their formal methods and will begin to look at fractions. After half term, we will also begin looking at decimals and percentages. In arithmetic, we have started to practice both short and long division.

Science & Foundation Subjects

In Science, the children will be doing an investigation which involves growing mould on bread. They will be making predictions about what they think will happen, and will be observing the changes and coming to their final conclusions. After half term we will be starting a new unit on the human body, including the circulatory system.

After half term, we will be starting our history unit on Ancient Greece. We will be looking at the rise of the Ancient Greek Empire, looking at timelines showing the different periods within the era, and learning about the Ancient Greek gods.

As the weather is changing it is important that your child brings a warm, waterproof coat to school every day.

Finally, please remember that it is important that you read with your child and question them about their book every day for at least 10 minutes and record this in their reading diary. Children should also be completing 1 quiz on Maths.co.uk per week which is set by the teacher.
