English & Maths

In Maths, we will be continuing to learn about numbers to 10,000. We will be learning about the value of digits in a number, composing and decomposing numbers by partitioning, comparing and ordering numbers on a number line and rounding numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1,000. We will also continue to have a focus on mental maths and efficient strategies, counting and estimating through reasoning and problem solving.

In English, we are continuing with our book, 'The Iron Man'. We will be writing a letter thanking the villagers for capturing the Iron Man on behalf of the government. We will then be moving on to looking at writing a menu for the Iron Man. We will continue to have a focus on grammar and sentence construction in lessons.

Science

In Science, we have been looking at 'Living Thing and Their Habitats'. We will continue investigating how we can classify plants and animals using branching databases. We will also be investigating how humans can change habitats and the effect this can have on plants and animals. Alongside our knowledge learning, we will be using our 'working scientifically' skills by asking questions, making predictions, making observations and recording and analysing results.

After half term, we will be studying 'States of Matter'.
