English & Maths

The children are continuing to read the story of 'How to Find Gold' by Viviane Schwartz.

The children have been focusing on using their phonics knowledge to segment words. They have then used this to write in a variety of different styles, including diary entries and letters. The children will be continuing to focus on their sentence writing next week whilst writing their own alternative ending to the story.

In Maths, the children will be continuing their learning of number knowledge, further exploring part-whole models. The children have already been exploring length, height, weight and narrative language within maths. They have been consolidating their subitising skills and counting, including comparison of numbers.

Science & Foundation Subjects

In Science, the children have been learning about the human body. We have been learning about body parts and their functions. The children have been exploring senses and their use through exploratory tasks.

In Art, the children have been exploring line work and experimenting with different media.

In Geography, the children have been learning about settlements and comparing characteristics between villages, towns and cities.

In History, we will be continuing to learn about castles. We have been comparing similarities and differences and looking at jobs within the castle grounds. We will be continuing our comparisons and looking at defence systems.
