Dear Parents & Carers

Welcome back for another year at Wintringham ! We hope you are as excited for your children to be back at school as we are and that you are looking forward to an important year ahead. We are sure you will agree that Year 6 is a significant year in the life of your children as they will embark on their last year at Primary school before moving on towards secondary school. Please find below a summary of the main learning areas during this first term, along with some general reminders.

Homework

Reading - children are expected to read for at least 10 minutes, 5 times a week from their AR book and this should be recorded in their reading diary (date, name of book, page number) and signed by an adult. The number of reads will be counted each Monday so children must ensure that they have their reading diary and their AR book with them (along with a 100 read book if they have one of these too). AR club will continue to run this term.

P.E.

P.E. for Year 6 will now be on a Monday. This may be subject to change so please ensure that a P.E. kit is in school all week. Please ensure that your child has the appropriate clothing and footwear in school for these lessons: a white t-shirt, navy football-style shorts (not cycling shorts), trainers, a warm top and jogging trousers (if it is colder). Please also ensure that all children have a named water bottle in school every day.

We are looking forward to an exciting term ahead and thank you in advance for your support.

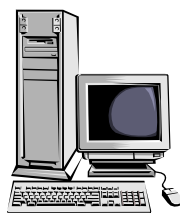

Autumn Term 2024 - Curriculum Areas for Year 6



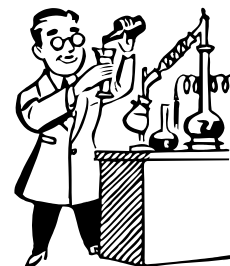
Art

This unit will focus on understanding Retrofuturism, developing skills in evaluating images and creating art through various drawing processes.



ICT

The children will be understanding how search engines work and will be developing searching skills to find relevant and accurate information online.



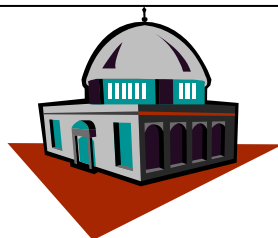
Science

Our first focus is on 'Living Things and their Habitats'. The children will learn about micro-organisms and the identification and classification of different animals and plants.



History

We will be studying Ancient Greeks in our History lessons, understanding their importance and the impact they had in the world.



Religion and Worldviews

The children will be looking at answering the question 'Why does religion look different around the world?' To do this, they will be engaging with a range of cultures, religions and worldviews.



Music

The children will be looking at dynamics, pitch and texture within music. They will be using these to create their own piece.



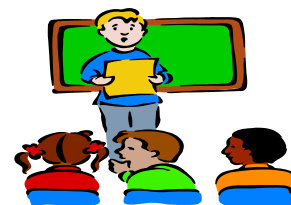
P.E.
