Dear Parents & Carers

Welcome back for another term at Wintringham Primary! We hope you are as excited for your children to be back at school as we are and that you are looking forward to an important term ahead. This is a particularly important term for Year 6, as we will be making our final preparations for SATs. The children did a fantastic job last term, showing commitment and determination, and I am confident they will do a great job in May. Please find below a summary of the main learning areas during this term, along with some general reminders.

Homework

Children will be set homework on a weekly basis. This includes:

- **Reading** – Children will be reading their Accelerated Reader (AR) book in school for 15 minutes each day, as well as continuing to read at home. They will also have a Reading Record, which can be used to note down their AR book or any other form of reading they enjoy, such as blogs, news articles, recipes, or poems. This allows teachers to see what the children are reading, discuss their choices with them, and celebrate their love of reading.
- **CPG SATs Practice** – Year 6 homework will be set weekly using the CGP SATs Practice books for English and Maths. Pupils will be given specific page numbers to complete and are expected to record these clearly in their reading diary. Homework will be set from Monday to Monday to allow plenty of time for completion. If homework is not completed, pupils will be required to complete it during break time. **This will run up until the end of SATs.**
- **Maths.co.uk** – Once SATs are finished, children will be set weekly homework on this. The children should have their log in details. If they do not, please come and speak to me.
- **Spelling shed** – this is an additional learning opportunity, and the spellings set will match the ones they are focusing on in class that week.

P.E.

P.E. for Year 6 will take place on **Mondays**; however, this may be subject to change, so please ensure that your child's P.E. kit is in school all week. The correct kit includes: a white t-shirt, navy or black football-style shorts (not cycling shorts), trainers, and a warm top and jogging trousers for colder weather. For safety reasons, children must not wear earrings during P.E. lessons; they should be able to remove them independently or wear plastic alternatives. Please also ensure that your child has a named water bottle in school every day.

We are looking forward to an exciting term ahead and thank you in advance for your support.

The children will be learning about the data handling unit: 'Skills showcase: Inventing a product' and 'Online Safety'.



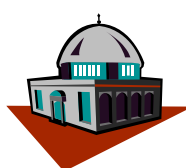
Science
